BLOOMZ	Bloomz is a multi-functional messaging app that lets teachers do things like give parents classrom-related updates or send them remindent abust things they need to do. REMIND	Like the faiking Points app, Remind allows teachers to translate messages into dozens of languages. However, it can also go further by sinding PDFs, photos, and even voice clips. With this app, you can send messages to individuals or groups. The latter option could be handy for class-specific updates. One shortcoming associated with Remind is that it offers only one-way communications-parents cannot respond to the messages. (Offered for IOS and Android.)
